"There are still some people with limited IT access so we cannot exclude them by making everything 100% web based, not just yet......"

"Online CPD vital to keep pace with other professional organisations and to ensure simplicity and ease of use for membership"

"I think that the AAPT CPD scheme is extremely worthwhile and rewarding"

"CPD should continue to be a rounded learning curve for all. Not everyone is academic but with continued points being awarded by reflective learning it allows for those who are more hands on to achieve too"

"I have found that still people think CPD is just about attending courses and getting a certificate. I have explained on a number of occasions to people that it's not, but that message seems to be getting lost. I think the CPD award is a good platform to show that CPD is important and that it is easy to keep a good level of CPD and that it's not just about courses. If we are going to push and I hope we are.. VRC then people need to get into the CPD mind set of come audit time a lot will fall and I/we really don't what that to happen"
